**FILLING-UP OF THE POST OF CHIEF VIGILANCE OFFICER**  
**ON DEPUTATION BASIS**

The RRTS is a rail based, high speed, high frequency commuter system connecting centres of metropolitan and big cities, towns and regional nodes across NCR seamlessly.

In the first phase, three RRTS corridors namely Delhi-Ghaziabad-Meerut, Delhi-Gurugram-SNB-Alwar and Delhi-Panipat are being implemented.

These high profile projects with high performing teams offer a once in a lifetime opportunity to make a significant and lasting contribution to improve quality of life of citizens in NCR and the country as a whole. 
