FILLING-UP OF THE POST OF CHIEF VIGILANCE OFFICER
ON DEPUTATION BASIS

National Capital Region Transport Corporation (NCRTC) – a Joint Venture of Govt of India and participating State Governments of Delhi, Haryana, Rajasthan and UP, under the administrative control of the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs is mandated for implementing the Nammo Bharat Project in National Capital Region (NCR), ensuring a balanced and sustainable urban development through better connectivity and access. The Nammo Bharat Project is a new, dedicated, high speed, rail based, high capacity, comfortable state of art, world class commuter service connecting regional nodes in NCR.

Three corridors are envisaged in the first phase, i.e. **Delhi-Meerut**, **Delhi-Gurugram-SNB-Alwar** and **Delhi-Panipat-Karnal**. At present, NCRTC is implementing the Delhi-Meerut corridor, of which 55 km stretch of the corridor from New Ashok Nagar to Meerut South has been opened for commercial revenue run.

These projects will not only provide a vital new transport infrastructure backbone to the region, but also act as a catalyst for development of suburban centers, creating jobs in the Indian economy and decongesting cities. The diversity of individuals and skills we require to execute the project is boundless. Further, the learning opportunities in an organization that is at its inflexion point of initiating some of the largest infrastructure projects in this country will be immense. NCRTC invites applications from Senior Administrative Grade (SAG) officers belonging to organised Group-‘A’ services, for the post of Chief Vigilance Officer on deputation basis. The detail of the post and eligibility criteria are given below: -

1.	Name of the post	Chief Vigilance Officer (CVO)
2.	No. of post	01 (One)
3.	Location	Delhi-NCR region
4.	Term of deputation	- For a period of 03 (Three) years initially, extendable by another 2 (Two) years subject to overall combined limit prescribed for Central deputation and/or being away from the cadre, as issued by DoPT from time to time.

5.	Eligibility criteria and conditions	i. Officers belonging to Organised Group-‘A’ services drawing their pay in the scale Senior Administrative Grade (SAG) in their cadres (Functional/ Non-functional) be eligible. ii. The officers having experience of working in technical disciplines of Group-‘A’ Engineering disciplines of Railways will be preferred. iii. The benchmark for selection would be at least ‘8.0’ in the APAR Gradings of the last 5 years and the integrity should be beyond doubt (Wherever number grading is not available, ‘Very Good’ will be acceptable. iv. The officers coming directly from the cadre should not be more than 56 years of age as on 1st April 2025 v. Officers, against whom any major/ minor penalty was imposed in their career as a result of disciplinary proceedings, are not eligible to apply for the post of CVO. vi. Consequent to their selection to the post of CVO, if an officer does not join within the prescribed time, his appointment would be treated as cancelled and the officer concerned would stand debarred from all kind of posting in Metro/ RRTS Companies for a period of 5 years from the date of issuing orders of his/ her appointment. vii. Officers working in NCRTC in regular, deputation or any other capacity are not eligible for appointment as CVO in NCRTC. Further, those officers who have worked in NCRTC in preceding 3 (three) years or have made direct official dealing with NCRTC are not eligible for appointment as CVO in NCRTC.
6.	Residential accommodation	NCRTC will be providing Company/ Leased Accommodation, as per entitlement of the officer who joins NCRTC on deputation. Officers occupying GPRA will be governed in terms of MoUD’s letter No. O.M. No. 12035/14/92-Pol.II dated 11.10.2000.
7.	Pay and Allowances	The officer would be eligible to draw parent department pay plus deputation allowance. Other benefits at par with ‘Functional Director’ in NCRTC.

HOW TO APPLY:

1. Eligible and interested officers may apply in the prescribed application format, Annexure-I, attached. All relevant documents should also be enclosed with the application.
