Sub- Computer Based Test (CBT) for the posts of Senior Executive/ Executive (Finance)

Ref.- Vacancy Notice No. 34/2022 Dated 29.06.2022

With reference to the above-mentioned vacancy notice, there will be a Computer Based Test (CBT) for shortlisting of candidates for interview. The Computer Based Test (CBT) is scheduled on **04.12.2022 (Sunday) at Test Centres in Delhi/NCR only**.

- 2. The Candidate should ensure that he/she fulfils the eligibility criteria and other requirements and that the particulars furnished are correct in all respect. In case it is detected at any stage of recruitment process that the candidate does not meet the eligibility criteria and/or the candidate has furnished any incorrect/false information or has suppressed any material fact(s), the candidature is liable to be rejected.
- 3. **Selection process**: Before interview the screening of the candidates will be made through a Computer Based Test (CBT) based on performance in CBT, shortlisted candidates will be called for interview in order of merit in the ratio of 1:5. The weightage of CBT and Interview will be 80:20.
- 4. In CBT, the Question paper will be of Objective Type (MCQ). Which will comprise 100 questions, each of one mark with time duration of 2 hrs. The question paper shall comprise -

- Reasoning - 20 marks

- General Knowledge/ Current Affairs - 20 marks

- Subject knowledge (Theoretical/ Practical)

(Corporate Accounts/ Preparation of Financial - 60 marks

Statements/ Direct & Indirect Taxation/

Fare box Revenue/ Non-Fare Box Revenue etc.)

- 5. The call letter indicating Date, Time and Venue will be sent separately to provisionally eligible candidates only through their registered E-mail ID, before 10 days of the test. NCRTC will not be responsible for non-receipt/ late receipt of email or mail reaching to spam folder.
- 6. Candidates are advised to keep visiting the Career section of NCRTC website (<u>www.ncrtc.in</u>), periodically for further instructions, if any.
